**Standard package (all prices are quoted in Canadian dollars):**

Our standard package is a 6 day trip, with clients arriving on a Tuesday and returning the following Monday. We charge \$440/day, which totals \$2640. We'll make every effort to accommodate clients who cannot stay the full 6 days. Clients are charged only for the time they're "in the field." That is, they're not charged for time spent in Kuujjuaq or Tasiujaq. The price of \$2640 includes: greeting service in Kuujjuaq and Tasiujaq; transport by seaworthy boat from Tasiujaq to the lodge; accommodations in heated cabins; hearty home-cooked meals in our dining facility (**see picture below**); hot showers and flush toilets; one guide per two fishermen with freighter canoe and outboard motor or one guide per three to four fisherman with a larger boat; landing nets and life jackets; preparation of fish or game for homebound transportation. Client should also bring their own towels, sleeping bag, and other personal items. The weather in summer is quite mild so the sleeping bag should be light.

The cost of air transport to Tasiujaq is separate. We're happy to make these arrangements at a special discounted rate available to Nunavik outfitters. In 2016, the First Air flight, Montreal to Kuujjuaq and return, costs clients \$1540, and the Air Inuit flight, Kuujjuaq to Tasiujaq and return, cost \$215 for clients over 60 years of age, and \$344 for clients under age 60. Clients for whom we make arrangements will receive a special baggage allowance: 140pounds in 2 pieces plus a rod case.

Clients are required to have a Provincial salmon-fishing license. A non-resident "catch and release" salmon license costs \$41.41. It allows the holder to keep the limit of char and trout, but they must return salmon to the water.

**Method of payment:**

Payment may be made directly to Billy Cain in cash or check upon arrival in

Tasiujaq. We have no facility to process credit cards. Alternatively, a check can be mailed in advance to Billy Cain or Henry Smith, or one can do an electronic bank transfer.
